

Checklist for Pyrotechnic Display Fireworks Woodford County

- It shall be unlawful for any person to display or allow to be displayed Pyrotechnic Display Fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Woodford County without a permit.
- An application for a Pyrotechnic Display Fireworks permit shall be filed at least 15 days in advance of the date of the display.
- The application for the permit shall contain identifying information for the person sponsoring the display, the exact location of the display, the exact date and time of the display and identifying information for the individual who is the licensed lead pyrotechnic operator supervising the display.
- A Certificate of Insurance from an insurance company licensed to do business in the State of Illinois evidencing a minimum of \$1,000,000 in liability coverage shall accompany this application.
- This application shall also be accompanied by a current and valid copy of the lead pyrotechnic operator's license.
- In accordance with State law a written approval letter or permit from the Chief of the Fire Department (or his/her designee) providing fire protection coverage to the area of the display shall accompany this application.
- After the permit has been granted, the possession, use and display of display fireworks shall be lawful for that purpose only. No permit granted shall be transferable.
- No permit shall be required for supervised displays of State or County Fair Associations.
- The applicant shall pay a permit fee in the amount of \$25.00 plus a Clerk's fee in the amount of \$20.00 to the Woodford County Clerk.
- Provided that the application requirements have been met by the applicant, a Pyrotechnic Display Fireworks Permit shall be issued by the Woodford County Clerk.
- Reschedule Clause-Notification of changed date of the event must be given to the County Clerk.
- Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a petty offense punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
- A copy of all documentation pertaining to the permit will be delivered to the Woodford County Sheriff's Department upon issuance of permit.
